The Organising Committee invites you to attend the 2017 NZAMT Mathematics Biennial Conference in Christchurch.

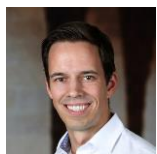
The conference will be showcasing innovative learning and teaching of Mathematics, with examples of best practice and thinking around the current issues in our classrooms.
